

COVID-19 We want to keep camp open for families. In order to do this, we ask that you only attend and lodge with your current household. We also ask that you maintain social distancing while at camp and wear a mask whenever possible. If you have any questions, don't hesitate to ask.

WELCOME TO CAMP

We are looking forward to your time here at Camp Koinonia. Before you arrive, we are providing you with some important information regarding our facilities. If you have any questions before you arrive or during your time at camp, please contact using the info below. We hope this will help you prepare for your time here at camp.



Arrival

- Check-in anytime 1pm-5pm (call if after)
- Check-in at the snack shack by the pool.
- Payment is due before you arrive and/or before you pull into your site.

- Set up a snack shack account for your household or individual kids.
- Sign up for your first family pool session.
- Rent Fire-pit for \$10.00 per night includes propane. Wood pits available as well and are \$20 for firewood bundle.

At Your Site or Cabin

- Place your RV/Campsite in the center of your power boxes and back in straight (don't go perpendicular to other RVs without permission. Ask for help if needed.
- Check the water, power, and surrounding areas. If there is anything that needs attention, please let us know.
- Every site should have a picnic table, 20/30 amp power and water.
- Respect your neighbors and introduce yourself safely when possible.
- Check-out is before noon but always ask for longer

Activity Schedule

- Pool Sign-Ups are by the pool entrance. Select 1 time per day and sign up for additional times after your first is complete. 2-3 families can be in the pool at one time. No more than 25 in pool area.
- Additional Activities: Escape Box, Archery and Fishing
- Fun Zone is always open. Play volleyball, basketball, boche ball, giant jenga, etc whenever you please.
- Pond fishing and feeding is always open. Please limit kept fish to 1 per guest. Please don't use boats without a lifeguard.
- Hiking trails around camp are always open. Please do not go in any buildings or past any gates.
- The Yurt has a ping-pong table and foosball.
- No fishing license needed. Just come enjoy.

Rules & Understandings

- Social Distancing will be encouraged and enforced if needed. We encourage groups to socialize safely and to spread out on their campsites. Only lodge with your current household.
- No public alcohol use.
- No inappropriate behavior of any kind. Again we are a family camp and wish to keep all of our guests comfortable and safe.
- Day Guests are \$10.00 per adult; \$5.00 per child at the gate. Appropriate swimming attire must be worn. No cotton shorts, basketball shorts etc. Swimsuits only.
- Guests must wear shoes or sandals around camp and on hiking trails.
- No more than 2 dogs per site. Dogs must always be leashed and under owners control. Pick up after your dog.
- Live burn fires are okay with a proper barrier. Firewood can be purchased on-site. Propane fires are okay. Rent a propane pit for \$10.00 per site per night. Charcoal Fire-pits are okay with bucket or hose. We have burn ban exemption. Propane grills okay.
- Quiet hours begin nightly at 10pm and last until 8am. Music should be kept to a reasonable levels at all times of the day and we ask that it remain family friendly at all times.
- No more than 2 vehicles per campsite. We encourage you to park your car in the parking lot instead of by your site.
- Guests must observe restricted area signs.
- Swimming in the pond is not allowed without a lifeguard. Swimming in the pool will ALWAYS have a lifeguard. The gate is locked during non-swimming hours.
- Fishing is allowed. Max 5 fish to keep; catch and release must use a barb less hook or pinched hook.
- Garbage: guests must collect all their garbage at the end of their stay and bring it with them or utilize the dumpster by the red garbage cans near pool.
